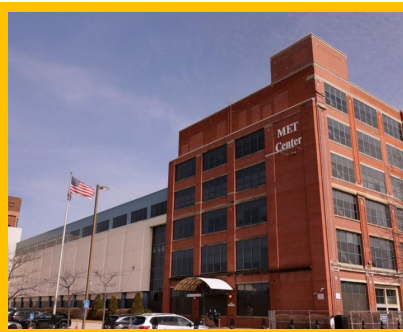

What is the Forklift Certification Training Program?

- This DESE, OSHA, and NSC Certified, 2-Day certification training focuses on preparing the entry-level workforce for careers in Forklift, Warehouse, and Material Handling.
- This three-year certification course covers the general principles of safe truck operation, the types of vehicle(s) being used in the workplace, the hazards of the workplace created by the use of the vehicle(s), and the general safety requirements of the OSHA standard.
- This training consists of a combination of formal instruction (e.g., lecture, discussion, interactive computer learning, video tape, written material), practical training (demonstrations performed by the trainer and practical exercises performed by the trainee), and evaluation of the operator's performance in the workplace.

Who Benefits from this Training?

- Unemployed, underemployed, or dislocated individuals interested in changing careers;
- Unskilled laborers seeking certification for career placement;
- Individuals who enjoy hands-on and industry-specific training in a simulated work environment
